Town Ordinance #2024- 2

NOW, THEREFORE, The Town of Montrose, County of Dane, State of Wisconsin, does ordain as follows:

Town of Montrose Parking Regulations

The Town Board of the Town of Montrose, Dane County, Wisconsin, has the specific authority under s. 349.13, Wis. stats., to adopt this ordinance of state traffic laws and parking regulations.

This ordinance, adopted by a majority of the town board on a roll call vote with a quorum present and voting and proper notice having been given, provides for the regulation of the stopping, standing, or parking of vehicles on town highways in the town as follows:

- A. The stopping, standing, or parking of vehicles on Paoli Road, Sun Valley Pkwy, Diane Ave Range Trail, Canal Street, and Harrison Street in the Town of Montrose is subject to the following restrictions and limitations:

PARKING REGULATIONS.

(1) The following definitions shall apply:

- (a) "Vehicle" shall include any motor vehicle, trailer, semi-trailer, mobile home, or any other movable equipment.
- (b) "Parking" shall mean leaving a vehicle, or permitting a vehicle to remain, on a street unattended, but shall not include the temporary stopping of emergency or service vehicles while responding to an emergency or inspecting, surveying, constructing, repairing, maintaining, or removing roadway or public utility facilities.

(2) **PARKING PROHIBITED AT ALL TIMES.** No person shall at any time park or leave standing any vehicle: (a) Upon any portion of a street, highway, or road, where and at the time when parking, stopping, or standing is prohibited by official traffic signs.

- (b) Within an intersection.
- (c) On a crosswalk.
- (d) Within 30 feet of a stop sign.
- (e) Within a fire lane.

(f) Within four (4) feet of the entrance to an alley, fire lane, private road or driveway.

(g) In any private driveway without the permission of the owner or lessee of the property on which said driveway is located, whether or not such driveway is posted to limit or restrict parking.

B. The town chairperson, or his or her designee, shall place appropriate traffic signs on the above-described highways.

C. No persons may operate any vehicle on the above-noted town highways in violation of the above-noted stopping, standing, or parking restrictions and limitations. Any violation shall be subject to a forfeiture of \$125 and may also be towed at the owner's expense.

This ordinance is effective on June 4, 2024. The town clerk shall properly post or publish this ordinance as required under s. 60.80, Wis. stats.


