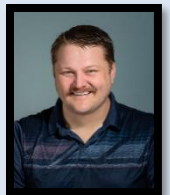


Introduction to your 2024 Town Board

Property Tax Second Installments

The Second Installment must be made payable to the **Walworth County Treasurer** and should be mailed to the **COUNTY** by **July 31, 2024**. They Must be paid to the county and NOT be paid at Town Hall.

Switching to a .gov domain demonstrates a commitment to compliance with these regulations, which is crucial for a government entity. This also improves visibility on search engines and online directories who often prioritize .gov websites in their search results. 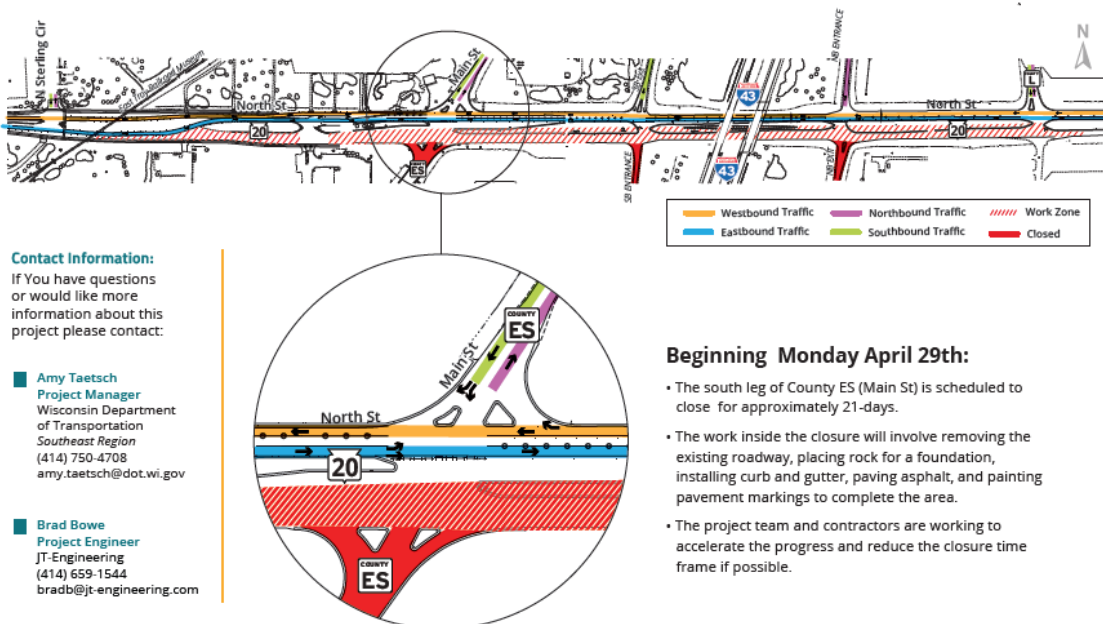

Beginning Monday April 29th:

- The south leg of County ES (Main St) is scheduled to close for approximately 21-days.
- The work inside the closure will involve removing the existing roadway, placing rock for a foundation, installing curb and gutter, paving asphalt, and painting pavement markings to complete the area.
- The project team and contractors are working to accelerate the progress and reduce the closure time frame if possible.
