BEULAH HEIGHTS CILVERT UPDATE



A few residents have reached out asking for updates on the Beulah Heights Culvert Project,

The contract has been awarded to RLP Diversified (3/9/2026). The recommendation letter of Bid Award from Lynch is attached. The project cannot be started until after April 16 as it must be 60 days after the public hearing. There is no official start date from the contractor yet. We have received all resident signatures of approval on the Construction Easement Agreement as of 3/19/2026. This easement allows temporary road access for residents impacted by the construction. Now, we can negotiate with CONTEC, the culvert supplier to see if there is a way to improve on their 7-week standard delivery estimate.

There are many moving parts in this project and we will keep you as up to date as possible through website notices like this one.

Thank you all for your patience as we navigate through this process and all of the associated approvals needed to keep it moving forward as quickly as possible, including that of the DNR which we have secured.
