

**TOWN OF EAST TROY RESOLUTION 2026-3  
AUTHORIZING THE APPOINTMENT OF SEPARATE TOWN CLERK AND TOWN  
TREASURER POSITIONS**

**WHEREAS**, a special meeting of electors of the Town of East Troy was held on January 19, 2026,  
and;

**WHEREAS**, Wisconsin Statute §60.80(1)(a) requires the town clerk to post or publish all  
~~resolutions, motions and other actions taken by the town electors within thirty (30) days of any town elector~~  
meeting, and;

**WHEREAS**, at the 2004 Annual Meeting of Electors, a motion to change the Town  
Clerk/Treasurer position from an elected position to an appointed position was made and unanimously  
passed as confirmed in Resolution 2004-5 after a referendum gave the Town Board that authority; and

**WHEREAS**, §60.305(4)(c) states a combined office may be revoked in the same way they were  
combined; and

**WHEREAS**, at the January 19, 2026 special meeting of electors, a motion was made and passed  
to allow the appointment of a separate Town Clerk and for a separate Town Treasurer; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town Board shall give the Town Attorney authority to amend the Town Code  
accordingly at the February 11, 2026 Town Board Meeting;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:**

1. That the Town Board of the Town of East Troy is hereby granted authority to make the  
appointment of a separate Town Clerk position.
2. That the Town Board of the Town of East Troy is hereby granted authority to make the  
appointment of a separate Town Treasurer position.
3. That pursuant to §60.30(1e)(c), a person appointed to the office of town clerk or town treasurer  
“shall serve for a term, not to exceed 3 years, that is set by the town board, and the person may  
be reappointed and may be dismissed by the board only for cause, as defined in s. 17.001”.


