

Dog Licensing

Dog licenses expire December 31st of each year.

- All dogs over 5 months of age must be licensed in the Town of Rhine.
- By state law **ALL** dogs over 4 months of age are required to be vaccinated for rabies by a veterinarian and re-vaccinated one year later, and every three years thereafter.
- No dog license will be issued without a current RABIES VACCINATION CERTIFICATE. An invoice from a veterinarian is not sufficient proof of rabies vaccination.
- Maximum number of dogs per parcel is 4.
- Please notify the clerk's office if you no longer own a dog that has been previously licensed in the Town of Rhine.

To obtain a dog license:

In Person – During regular Town Hall hours, Tuesday and Wednesday from 11:30 am to 4:30 pm. Bring the rabies vaccination certificate and cash or check for the applicable fee to the Town Hall, W5250 County Rd. FF, Elkhart Lake, WI 53020.

By Mail - Send a **COPY** of the rabies vaccination certificate, a self-addressed stamped envelope, and a check made to: Town of Rhine, for the applicable fee to: Town of Rhine, W5250 County Rd. FF, Elkhart Lake, WI 53020. The clerk's office will mail your dog license.

Drop box – The drop box is located to the left of the front door of the Town Hall at W5250 County Rd. FF, Elkhart Lake, WI 53020. Please include a **COPY** of the rabies vaccination certificate, a self-addressed stamped envelope, and a check made to: Town of Rhine, for the applicable fees. The clerk's office will mail your dog license.

Fees:

\$14.00 – Unaltered Dog

\$7.00 – Spayed/Neutered Dog

\$55.00 – Kennel Licenses (up to 12 dogs). Contact the clerk's office at 920-876-3413.

\$20.00 – Additional late fee per dog if dog is licensed after March 31st.

**Dog license fees cannot be combined with any other payments,
always submit a separate check.**

As a dog owner you are required to vaccinate, license, and keep control of your dog.

Failure to do any of the above is a violation of State and local laws and is subject to fines.
