ORDINANCE 01.2025 Amending Chapter 157 Electrical Standards

The Town Board of the Town of Polk, Washington County, Wisconsin, upon proper notice and with quorum present, and pursuant to the authority of Wis. Stat., § 101.86, hereby ordains the following Amendment to Chapter 157-4 A(1), 157-4 C and 157-6. of the Town of Polk Code of Ordinances, Electrical Standards:

157-4(1) Electrical Permits

<u>A.</u>

Permits required.

<u>(1)</u>

No person shall perform electrical work having a cost of \$200 or more, as defined in § <u>157-2</u> of this chapter, without first obtaining an electrical permit from the Town's Electrical Inspector.

<u>C.</u>

Issuance; term. When the Electrical Inspector is satisfied that the work proposed by the applicant can be done in conformity with the provisions of this chapter, and after the appropriate fees have been paid, they shall issue the permit. Such permit shall be good for the continuous performance of the work named thereon. A permit shall automatically expire if work has not been commenced within 12-months of the date of issuance or when work ceases for a period of 90 days without good and reasonable cause for same and shall automatically expire on completion of the work for which it was issued; provided the Electrical Inspector may, upon notice, suspend or revoke such permit for violation of the provisions of this chapter.
