



ANNUAL DOG LICENSE APPLICATION

Every person who owns, harbors, or keeps a dog more than five (5) months of age on January 1, or five (5) months of age within the license year shall annually, or within 30 days from the date such dog becomes five (5) months of age, pay a dog license tax and obtain a license as provided by the provisions of Chapter 174 of the Wisconsin Statutes. **An additional \$10.00 late fee shall be charged for each license if the owner fails to obtain a license prior to April 1 or within 30 days of acquiring ownership.** State law requires all dogs to be vaccinated against rabies.

You may obtain your Dog License in person or by mail. Bring in or mail your completed form and license fee **before April 1** to: **Town of Polk, Treasurer, P O B o x 19, Slinger, WI 53086.** Town office hours are Monday, Wednesday, and Thursday 7:30 a.m. to Noon, and Tuesday from 2:30 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. *Monday and Wednesday are by appointment only.

IMPORTANT: If you no longer have your dog, please notify us to remove their name from our records.
