**The Town of Polk does not accept garbage.** Residents and Business must contract for garbage pick up individually. The town does not provide any roadside pickup of household waste.

We do not accept tires, TV's, microwaves, appliances with Freon, flashlight batteries, antifreeze, paint, propane tanks, and other hazardous waste. Call Washington County Clean Sweep Program at 262.335.4800 for information on hazardous waste disposal.

<b>Newspapers, Magazines, Office Paper and Cardboard ONLY</b>	Newspapers, Magazines, Cardboard Card Stock, Office Paper, Books, Envelopes, Paper <b>Other Examples:</b> Brown Paper Tape, Computer Printouts, File Folders-Manila, Glued Pads, Tablets, Phone Books, Post-It Notes, and ANY Junk Mail	Bathroom Waste Paper(towels, toilet paper), Wrapping paper, Carbon Paper, Cellophane, Cloth, Cork, Foil, Polystyrene Styrofoam, anything Waxed, Candy Wrappers, Napkins, Paper Cups, Styrofoam Cups, Styrofoam or Paper Food Containers, Photographs, Fiberboard, Labels and Label Backings
