Section 1. General

- A. These regulations shall be known as the Regulation of Park and Property Code of the Village of Oliver, Wisconsin.
- B. It is the propose of this ordinance to regulate, protect, and preserve the park from damage or desecration.

Section 2. Definition

A. The term "park," as hereinafter used in this ordinance, shall include all grounds and structures, which are or may be located within any area dedicated to the public use as a park.

Section 3. Park

- A. No person shall deface, damage, or destroy any property in the park or pick, damage or destroy any flowers, shrubs, lawns or trees.
- B. No person shall remove benches, tables or other park equipment from the park without Village authorization.
- C. No person shall bring glass containers into the park. All refuse and waste shall be removed from the park or disposed of in containers provided for that purpose.
- D. All animals brought to the park shall be properly restrained. The owner or handler shall be responsible for the proper disposal of any animal's waste.
- E. Amusement devices, tents, trailers or any similar structures shall not be permitted without Village authorization.

Section 4. Park Hours

- A. The Village Park and Village owned parking lots shall be closed from 10:00 PM until 6:00 AM.
- B. No person shall be in the Village Park or Village owned parking lots during hours of closing.
- C. Open hours may be extended in the park and parking lots where activities authorized by the Village Board are being conducted and when permission to extend said hours has been granted.

Section 5. Penalties

A. Any person who causes physical damage to or destroys any public property shall be liable for the cost of repairing or replacing such damaged or destroyed property. The parent or parents of any unemancipated minor child who violates Section 3 (A) of this ordinance shall also be held liable for the cost of repairing or replacing such damaged or destroyed property in accordance with Section 895.035, Wisconsin Statutes.
