RESOLUTION OF THE VILLAGE BOARD OF THE VILLAGE OF OLIVER A RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR AN ADVISORY REFERENDUM ON THE QUESTION OF ALLOWING ALL VILLAGE STREETS TO BE USED AS ATV AND UTV ROUTES IN THE VILLAGE OF OLIVER, DOUGLAS COUNTY, WISCONSIN.

WHEREAS, The Village Board deems it desirable and in the best interest of the Village to direct the Village Clerk to submit the question of whether to allow all village streets to be used as ATV and UTV routes to the electors of the Village by means of an advisory referendum to be held on April 3, 2018:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE VILLAGE BOARD OF THE VILLAGE OF OLIVER, DOUGLAS COUNTY, WISCONSIN, AS FOLLOWS:

1. The Village Clerk is hereby directed to call an advisory referendum to be held in said Village at the Village's regular polling place on April 3, 2018, for the purpose of submitting the following question to the qualified electors of the Village:

Should the Village Board allow all village streets to be used as ATV and UTV routes?

- 2. The advisory referendum, including all notices and election procedures, shall be held in accordance with the applicable laws of the State of Wisconsin. The Clerk is directed to post all required notices and procedures in the three Village posting places in lieu of publication.
