TOWN OF ELBA TRAFFIC ORDINANCE

Dodge County, Wisconsin April 1997

SECTION 1.0 Title

This Ordinance is entitled the "Town of Elba Traffic Ordinance", for the Town of Elba, Dodge County, Wisconsin.

1.1 Authority

The Town Board of the Town of Elba has the specific statutory authority, powers and duties, pursuant to the specific statutory sections noted in this ordinance and/or by its adoption of village power under Sec. 60.10, (1995-96) Wis. Stats., to regulate, control, prevent and enforce against, in the Town of Elba certain uses, activities, businesses and operations by persons that may affect the traffic in the Town of Elba.

1.3 <u>General Provisions</u>

The Town of Elba establishes, by this ordinance, in compliance with Chapters 346 and 349 (1995-96) Wis. Stats., the following maximum speed limits on the following public highways, roads, streets and alleys in the Town of Elba:

- (a) <u>lemkin Road</u> -- **30 mph** speed limit, from Columbus City Limits north 3803 feet approximately.
- (b) Oxbow Road -- 35 mph speed limit, beginning at Hwy 16 & 60, south 1884 feet approximately.
- (c) <u>Duffy Road -- 35 mph</u> advisory speed limit between the curve ahead signs, 1638 feet approximately.
- (d) <u>Lange Road</u> -- **35 mph** speed limit beginning at Hwy 73, going east 3721 feet approximately
- (e) <u>Elba Heights Subdivision</u> -- **25 mph** entering Hickory Drive off of Lange Road, around to Oak Grove Drive and back on to Hickory Drive, 3234 feet approximately.

(f) Baden Street -- 25 mph from Duffy Property across Hwy 16 & 60 to railroad tracks, 1532 feet approximately and 327 feet approximately West from Baden Street to Roads edge of Campell Street.

(g) Campell Street -- 25 mph North of Hwy 16 & 60 to Roads edge, 894 feet approximately.

1.4 Other Provisions

Except as specifically noted otherwise in this ordinance, in Chapters 340 to 348, (1995-96) Wis. Stats., inclusive, Chapter 350 and Chapter 941, (1995-95) Wis. Stats., describing and defining regulations with respect to vehicles, traffic and snowmobiles for which the penalty is a forfeiture only, including penalties to be imposed and procedure for prosecution, are hereby adopted and incorporated by reference, by the Town of Elba and made part of this ordinance as if fully set forth herein.

Any future amendments, modifications, revisions, additions or deletions of the above noted statutory chapters shall be incorporated herein and made part of this ordinance in order to secure uniform state regulation of traffic on the public highways, roads, streets and alleys of the State of Wisconsin.

1.5 Adoption of Ordinance

The Town Board of the Town of Elba has, by adoption of this ordinance, confirmed the specific statutory authority, powers and duties noted in the specific sections of this ordinance and has established, by these sections and this ordinance, the regulations, controls and enforcement against certain uses, activities, businesses and operations by persons that may affect the traffic in the Town of Elba.
