ORDINANCE NO. 2024-01 TOWN OF WOODVILLE, CALUMET COUNTY, WISCONSIN

ORDINANCE REGARDING ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLE ROUTE

1-1 Intent

The Town of Woodville, Calumet County adopts the following all-terrain vehicle (ATV) and utility terrain vehicle (UTV) ordinance for the operation of ATVs and UTVs upon the roadways listed in section 1-3.

Following due consideration of the recreational value to connect trail opportunities and weighted against possible dangers, public health, liability aspects, terrain involved, traffic density and history of automobile traffic, the ordinance from which this article is derived has been created.

1-2 Statutory Authority

This route is created pursuant to town authority as authorized by Wis. Stats. § 23.33(8)(b). The applicable provisions of Wis. Stats. § 23.33 regulating ATV and UTV operation pursuant to routes are adopted.

1-3 Routes

The following roads are designated as routes:

• All Town of Woodville roads.

1-4 Conditions

As a condition for the use of this route, the following conditions shall apply to all operators (and passengers where applicable):

- 1. No ATV/UTV shall be operated at a speed greater than 35 miles per hour.
- 2. All ATV/UTV routes in the township shall be posted with a maximum speed limit of 35 miles per hour unless posted at a lower speed.
- 3. Routes must be signed in accordance with NR 64.12.
- 4. All ATV/UTV operators shall ride single file.
- 5. All ATV/UTV operators shall slow the vehicle to ten mile per hour or less when operating within 100 feet of a person not on a vehicle or machine.

1-5 Enforcement

This article shall be enforced by any law enforcement officer authorized to enforce the laws of the State of Wisconsin.

1-6 Penalties

Wisconsin state all-terrain vehicle and utility terrain vehicle penalties as found in Wis. Stats. § 23.33(13)(a), are adopted by reference.

1-7 Severability

The provision of this article shall be deemed severable and it is expressly declared that Town of Woodville would have passed the other provisions of this article irrespective of whether or not one or more provisions may be declared invalid. If any provision of this article or the application to any person or circumstances is held invalid, the remainder of the article and the application of such provisions to other persons circumstances shall not be deemed affected.
