Resolution 2009-10 - Resolution for Electors to Adopt the Town Tax Levy at Special Town Meeting of the Electors

Whereas, Sec. 60.10 (1)(a) of the Wis. Statutes authorizes the town electors of a town to adopt the town tax levy at a town meeting of the electors;

Whereas, a special town meeting of the electors has been called for this 11th day of November, 2009;

Whereas, the electors after proper notice have at a special town meeting vote authorized the Town of Woodville to exceed the maximum allowable state levy limit;

Now, therefore, the special town meeting of the Town of Woodville, Calumet County, Wisconsin, by a majority vote of the eligible electors voting on this 11th day of November, 2009 duly assembled and voting resolves and orders as follows:

BE IT RESOLVED, the town electors of the Town of Woodville, Calumet County, Wisconsin, hereby adopt the town tax levy for 2009 to be collected in 2010 at \$157,947.00.

The town clerk shall properly post or publish this resolution as required by law under Sec. 60.80 of Wis. Statutes within 30 days of the below noted adoption date.
