ADOPTING THE CALUMET COUNTY HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN

FISCAL IMPACT: None

WHEREAS, the Town of Woodville recognizes the threat that natural hazards pose to people and property; and

WHEREAS, undertaking hazard mitigation actions before disasters occur will reduce the potential for harm to people and property and save taxpayer dollars; and

WHEREAS, an adopted all-hazards mitigation plan is required as a condition of future grant funding for mitigation projects; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Woodville participated jointly in the planning update process with Calumet County and the other local units of government within the County to prepare an updated Hazard Mitigation Plan;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Town Board of the Town of Woodville, hereby adopts the Calumet County Hazard Mitigation Plan as an official plan; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Calumet County Emergency Management Department will submit, on behalf of the Town, the adopted Hazard Mitigation Plan to Wisconsin Emergency Management and Federal Emergency Management Agency officials for final review and approval. Minor changes made upon advice from Wisconsin Emergency Management and Federal Emergency Management Agency will not require re-adopting this resolution.
