

Ordinance 07-2023 (349.11 Ordinance to lower speed limit on Town Roads)

Town of Woodville, Calumet County  
State of Wisconsin

The Town Board of the Town of Woodville, Calumet County, Wisconsin, has the specific authority under s. 349.11, Wis. stats., to adopt this ordinance.


This ordinance, adopted by a majority of the town board on a roll call vote with a quorum present and voting and proper notice having been given, provides for the reduction of the speed limits on certain town roads in the town as follows:

- A. Pursuant to s. 349.11, Wis. stats., effective August 1, 2023 speed limits on certain Town of Woodville town roads are reduced or modified as follows: North Marx road beginning South of Highway 10 to North of County Road B shall be reduced to 45 MPH.
- B. Pursuant to s. 349.11 (5), Wis. stats., the town chairperson, or his or her designee, shall place appropriate traffic signs at the above-described locations on or before the effective date of this ordinance.\*
- C. No person may operate any vehicle on the above-noted town roads in violation of the above-noted speed limits. Any violation shall be subject to penalties under s. 346.60, Wis. stats.


This ordinance is effective on August 1st, 2023.
