

**ORDINANCE NO. 2024-02**  
**TOWN OF WOODVILLE,**  
**CALUMET COUNTY, WISCONSIN**

**ORDINANCE REGARDING OUTDOOR BURNING**

1-1     Prohibited

Except as provided in subsection 1-2 below, no person shall ignite or burn outdoors any trash, solid waste, hazardous waste or any other type of waste within the Town of Woodville.

1-2     Exceptions

Subsection 1-1 above of this Ordinance shall not apply to the following:


- a.     Persons who burn small amounts of charcoal or other similar combustible materials for domestic cooking outdoors at their residence or in public parks.
- b.     Persons who burn wood, brush, or leaves. The fire shall not be located within fifteen feet of a structure or property line. This exception does not apply upon a declared public fire emergency by the State Department of Natural Resources.


1-3     Violations; penalties


- a.     Any person violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance or knowingly aiding or abetting another in the violation thereof shall first receive one written warning during the person's lifetime.
- b.     Thereafter, any person violating any or the provisions of this Ordinance or knowingly aiding or abetting another in the violation thereof, shall upon conviction, pay a forfeiture of \$200.00 per incident and the costs and attorney fees in prosecution, which each day the violation of this Ordinance constitutes a separate offense.
