

ORDINANCE NO. 2024-04

CALUMET COUNTY, WISCONSIN

ORDINANCE REGARDING LOWERING SPEED LIMIT ON BRANT ST. JOHN ROAD

This ordinance, adopted by a majority of the town board on a roll call vote with a quorum present and voting and proper notice having been given, provides for the reduction of the speed limits on certain town roads in the town as follows:

- A. Pursuant to s. 349.11, Wis. stats., effective June 1, 2024 speed limits on certain Town of Woodville town roads are reduced or modified as follows: Brant St. John Road from Highway 10 County Road KK shall be reduced to 45 MPH.
- B. Pursuant to s. 349.11 (5), Wis. stats., the town chairperson, or his or her designee, shall place appropriate traffic signs at the above-described locations on or before the effective date of this ordinance.
- C. No person may operate any vehicle on the above-noted town roads in violation of the above-noted speed limits. Any violation shall be subject to penalties under s. 346.60, Wis. stats.

This ordinance is effective on June 1, 2024. —

The town clerk shall properly post or publish this ordinance as required under s. 60.80, Wis. stats.
