

Sex Offender Information Bulletin Community Notification

The Brown County Sheriff's Office is notifying about the following information pursuant to Wisconsin State Statute 301.46(2m) which authorizes law enforcement agencies to inform the public of a sex offender's relocation when, in the discretion of the agency, the release of information will enhance public safety, awareness and protection. The individual who appears on this notification has been convicted of a sex offense. He is NOT wanted by the police at this time. This notification is not intended to increase fear; rather, it is our belief that an informed public is a safer public. Sex offenders have always lived in our communities; but it was not until Act 440 was enacted that law enforcement is able to share this information with the community. Citizen abuse of this information to threaten, intimidate or harass registered sex offenders will NOT be tolerated.

On 07/31/2025 Roger Adamski will be relocated to the following address: 8320 Dickinson Rd. Greenleaf, town of Morrison. His convictions include one counts of first-degree sexual assault of a child. He will need to comply with all rules of supervision and is a lifetime registrant of the Wisconsin Sex Offender Registry. Supervised release rules include: No contact with victims; no taverns/bars/liquor stores; no consumption of alcohol or drugs. He is also subject to lifetime GPS tracking.

Additional Sex Offender Information: As 07/29/25, there are over 27,431 sex offenders who have registered as required in the State of Wisconsin. There are 6,117 registered sex offenders currently under community supervision in the state. There are 711 registrants in Brown County, 267 of which are on community supervision.
