FYI Items:

- **Town Hall Rental-** Rent the Town Hall for garage sales, reunions, etc. \$50/day - Contact the Clerk
- **Driveway Permits** - \$35, Chairman must approve
- **Burning Permits** –
 - Snow on the ground - no permit required.
 - No snow - call the Town Chairman for a permit, no charge. You will then need to call the Barron Co. Sheriff's Department at 715-537-3106 so they can let dispatch know. If you don't call, fire trucks may show up, and you will be responsible for ALL costs.
- **Snow Plowing** – State law prohibits plowing snow across town roads from driveways. It is a safety hazard for the snowplow driver and equipment; violators may be fined and liable for damages
- **Fire Calls** – Homeowners & Landowners are required to pay the total cost for firefighters and fire trucks called out to their property.
- **Sand/Salt** - Available at the Town Shop for residents no charge if they need a pail or two.
