Be it enacted by the Town Board of the Town of Hammond as follows:

Section 1.

There is hereby established an extension on the moratorium on applications for the review and approval of permits for Wind Energy Facilities within the Town of Hammond, as said moratorium was established by Local Law No. 2 of the year 2010. During the extended moratorium period, no applications for the review and/or approval for the siting, construction or placement of Wind Energy Facilities within the Town of Hammond shall be accepted and no review of proposed Wind Energy Facilities shall be conducted by the Planning Board.

Section 2.

The period of the moratorium extension established by this Local Law shall be one (1) year from the expiration of the moratorium established by Local Law No. 2 of the year 2010.

Section 3.

This Local Law shall take effect upon the filing with the Secretary of State as required by the Municipal Home Rule Law.
