# New Purchases For The Hammond Highway Department

The Town of Hammond Highway Department is starting the year by updating some of its heavy equipment that was long overdue to be replaced. The first purchase was a new heavy-duty pickup truck to replace the 1988 model that has been in service. This purchase was accomplished using Consolidated Highway Improvement Program Funds. The Town Board also authorized the purchase of a 2017 plow truck to replace a 2004 unit that has reached the end of its useful life. This was accomplished using monies set aside in capital funds over the past 4 years. The truck was recently displayed to students at Hammond Central School and a short presentation was given to students explaining the operations and uses of the plow truck. The Town Board has plans to purchase an additional plow truck to replace a non-serviceable 2003 unit. It should be noted that because of careful planning and budgeting, the trucks were purchased without having to raise taxes.

### ASSESSOR UPDATE

New STAR (School Tax Relief) applicants will receive a credit in the form of a check directly from NY State instead of receiving a school property tax exemption. The amount of your STAR benefit is the same regardless of how you receive it. New Basic and Enhanced STAR applicants need to register with the NYS Tax Department to receive a STAR check. Jim Gleason, Code Enforcement Officer, reminds everyone that most construction, remodeling, outbuildings, and all septic system installation and repair require a building permit. He can be contacted at 315-324-5321, Ext. 12 or by email. Office hours are Monday and Saturday 9:00-11:00 AM, or by appointment. Many changes in the use of property and all sub-dividing of any property must be reviewed by the Planning Board. Appointments can be scheduled for informal review of proposed projects by contacting the Planning Board Chairman William Billings. #### **BOATER SAFETY CLASS SCHEDULED FOR HAMMOND**

The "Boating Safely" course is required in NY State for anyone age 14 and older to operate a personal watercraft (i.e. jet ski) and for young adults ages 10-18 to operate a boat alone, and anyone, born on or after May 1, 1996, to operate a motorized boat unsupervised. The course will be held August 15 & 16 at Hammond School, 5-9 PM. Class fee: \$35. Pre-registration is required. Call: 315-393-6488.

#### UPDATE ON 21 MAIN STREET TOWN OFFICE BUILDING

The town board is continuing to explore options for the 21 South Main Street Building location including remodeling or the possible demolition of the existing structure and building of a new one. Indian River Lakes Engineering has drawn up preliminary plans for approval or changes to the design. The town board is continuing to gather information from other towns who have similar needs and is also reviewing input from USDA resources to make a well-advised decision for our community. This space would eventually be occupied by all of the present town offices and the library.

# RABIES CLINIC, LICENSING, AND SPAY/NEUTER INFO

Reasons to license your dog with your town clerk:

It is a law created to protect dogs from cruelty and rabies. Licensing helps reunite lost dogs with their owners. License fees support the efforts of our local animal shelters. Licensing simplifies medical follow-up for individuals possibly exposed to rabies infected dogs. The cost of the license is far less than the penalty without one.

Town of Hammond Residents: In the last year there has been an increase in rabies cases throughout Jefferson, Lewis, and St. Lawrence Counties. Rabies cases typically spike in summer. I cannot emphasis enough the importance of the NYS law that requires all dogs older than 4 months to be licensed within the town they reside. Licensing ensures that all dogs have been properly vaccinated against rabies for the protection of both you and your neighbors. Please spread the word to license your pet!

Town and Village Rabies Clinic, Wednesday May 24th 6:00PM-7:30PM @ Town Barn. Three-year vaccinations are available with a current rabies certificate. A rabies tag is not acceptable proof. Dogs and cats must be at least 4 months old. All animals must be under control of an adult. Dogs must have a collar and leash. Cats must be in a carrier. For other rabies clinic dates in surrounding areas, call Clerk Pam Burton at 315-324-5321.
