LOCAL LAW <u>3</u> OF THE YEAR 2023 TOWN OF HAMMOND, COUNTY OF ST. LAWRENCE

Title: Volunteer Firefighter and Volunteer Ambulance Workers Real Property Tax Exemption

BE IT ENACTED BY THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF HAMMOND, COUNTY OF ST. LAWRENCE AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Legislative Intent

It is the intent of the town board of the Town of Hammond, County of St. Lawrence to provide a real property tax exemption to qualifying volunteer firefighters and ambulance workers as set forth in Real Property Tax Law Section 466-f.

SECTION 2. Authority

Real Property Tax Law Section 466-f authorizes the town board to adopt a local law providing a real property tax exemption of up to ten percent of the assessed value of real property owned by qualifying volunteer firefighters and ambulance workers.

SECTION 3. Grant of Real Property Tax Exemption for Volunteer Firefighters and Volunteer Ambulance Workers

The Town Board of the Town of Hammond, County of St. Lawrence hereby provides a real property tax exemption of ten percent (10%) of the assessed value of real property for individuals that meet the following qualifications:

- The individual is an enrolled and certified member of an incorporated volunteer fire company, fire department, or volunteer ambulance service that serves the Town of Hammond and has a minimum of two (2) years of service; and
- The individual resides in the town and the property receiving the benefit is the primary residence of the individual and is used exclusively for residential purposes, and any portion of the property not used for residential purposes shall be subject to taxation
- The Town Board has determined the procedure for certification of qualified firefighters based on criteria and a methodology provided by the Hammond Fire and Rescue. Points are awarded to active members for attending meetings, responding to calls, responding to mutual aid, standby, training, marching, monthly work details, after call work detail, attending committee meetings, boot drive, field day, other work details, other fundraisers and serving on the executive board. Active members are required to earn a specific number of points based on their seniority in the organization.

SECTION 4. Grant of Lifetime Real Property Tax Exemption for Certain Volunteer Firefighters and Volunteer Ambulance Workers

The Town Board of the Town of Hammond, County of St. Lawrence hereby provides a lifetime real property tax exemption of ten percent (10%) of the assessed value of real property for any individuals that have been certified by the authority having jurisdiction over an incorporated volunteer fire company, fire department or incorporated volunteer ambulance service as having accrued twenty or more years of active service, so long as their primary residence remains within the Town of Hammond.

SECTION 5. Severability

If any clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, or part of this local law or the application thereof to any person, firm, or circumstance, shall be adjusted by any court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid or unconstitutional, such order or judgment shall not affect, impair, or invalidate the remainder thereof, but shall be confined in its operation to the clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, or part of this local law or in its application to the person, individual, firm or corporation or circumstances, directly involved in the controversy in which such judgment or order shall be rendered.

SECTION 6. Effective date

This local law shall be effective immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State.
