**Snow Plowing and Road Maintenance-** are done by Norton Excavating. All concerns involving snow plowing or road maintenance should be addressed to the Casey Town Board at the monthly meeting and NOT Norton Excavating.

**Driveway and Building Permits-** An approved Town Driveway Permit must be submitted to the Washburn County Zoning Office when applying for building permits. Driveway Permit applications can be obtained on our website or from Casey Town Clerk Corinne Slabaugh, at (715) 635-7580. Assisting us with this process the County Zoning Office will not issue any building/sanitary permits unless a completed and approved Town Driveway Permit is presented. Contact Washburn County Zoning Office for zoning laws & forms at (715) 468-4690.

**Fireworks Usage-** Wisconsin statutes require a permit for use of all non hand-held fireworks and will be issued through June 29<sup>th</sup> by Casey Town Board Chairperson. Valid only if burning conditions warrant. The permit allows detonation **between the hours of 9 pm and midnight from Saturday July 2<sup>nd</sup> thru <b>Monday July 4<sup>th</sup>.** A separate application and permit must be obtained for each day of fireworks usage. Please check our website for information and permit applications.

**Road Construction**- Re-engineering of Island Lake Road will continue from the present area of reengineering south toward Highway E.
