ANNUAL TOWN CLEAN-UP DAY

**Casey Town Hall - Intersection of Lower McKenzie Road and Dunn Lake Road
Saturday September 12, 2026 – 8:00 am - noon (or until dumpsters are full)**

Items up to a maximum listed will be accepted at no charge:

- 4 vehicle (car or light truck) tires only
- 2 large appliances (white ware or other)
- 1 computer desktop component
- 1 television
- 2 car or truck batteries
- 1 mattress or box spring or upholstered furniture
- General refuse

There will be a charge for the following items:

- \$15.00 for each additional tire
- \$25.00 for each additional television or computer desktop component
- \$20.00 for each additional large appliance
- \$30.00 for each additional mattress, box spring or upholstered furniture

Items **NOT** accepted:

- Paints (unless empty and dry cans of latex paint), insecticides, solvents, household chemicals, hazardous wastes, fluorescent bulbs, any other volatile organic chemicals (VOC's), expired medications, all beverage containers, household garbage, construction debris (lumber, wood, shingles, etc.), large truck or tractor tires.

Tree brush & stumps will be accepted at the new disposal site in Section 21 with entry on Lower McKenzie Road one mile west of Loon Lake between 9 am and noon.

All assembled items (patio furniture, grills, etc.) must be disassembled prior to disposal.

PLEASE BRING ALONG HELP FOR UNLOADING YOUR ITEMS AS HELP IS LIMITED, BE PREPARED TO UNLOAD ITEMS YOURSELF.

Those leaving items at the Casey Town Hall prior to or after hours of operation documented by our surveillance cameras will be prosecuted.

Proof of Town of Casey residency and/or property ownership may be required (utility bill, tax statement with name and town address).
