Ordinance 2024-2

Ordinance Enacting Two Shifts for Election Workers State of Wisconsin • The Town of Stubbs • Rusk County

The Town Board of the Town of Stubbs, Rusk County, Wisconsin, has the specific authority under s. 7.30(1) to adopt this ordinance.

This ordinance, adopted by a majority of the town board on a roll call vote with a quorum present and voting and proper notice having been given, provides for the selection of 2 sets of officials to work at different times on each election day as follows:

- A. There may be 2 shifts for election workers on all election days. The first shift shall commence at 6:30 am and end at 2:00pm. The second shift shall commence at 2:00pm and end with completion of all required election day duties that follow the closure of the polls, including additional time for canvassing at the request of the clerk.
- B. The town board may for each election appoint election inspectors to serve between the hours of 6:30am and 2:00pm and election inspectors to serve between the hours of 2:00pm and poll closing time at the polling place in the town, including additional time for canvassing at the request of the clerk. Each additional election inspector shall serve as a greeter to answer questions and to direct electors to the proper locations for registration and voting and shall be available to substitute for other election officials who must leave the room during the voting process.

At all times the election inspectors on duty shall be an odd number with additional inspectors withdrawing from any adjudications that may be required.
