**ORDINANCE NO. 2025 - 1**

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE TOWN ORDINANCES OF THE TOWN OF  
STUBBS, RUSK COUNTY, WISCONSIN**

The Town Board of the Town of Stubbs, Rusk County, Wisconsin, hereby ordains § 2025-1 of the Ordinances of the Town of Stubbs is adopted to read as follows:


**§ 2025-1. Firearms and Dangerous Weapons in Town Buildings**

- A. Pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 943.13(1m)(c)4, no person shall enter or remain in any part of a building owned, occupied or controlled by the Town or remain in the building while carrying a firearm or other dangerous weapon as defined by Wis. Stat. § 939.22(10) if the Town has notified the person not to enter or remain in the building while carrying a firearm or other dangerous weapon.
- B. The Town Chair shall cause signs to be posted at all entrances of all buildings occupied or owned by the Town of Stubbs in a prominent location with minimum dimensions of 5 inches by 7 inches and accordance with Wis. Stat. § 943.13(2)(bm) stating that no person shall enter or remain in any such building while carrying a firearm or dangerous weapon.
- C. Nothing in this section shall be construed to apply to prohibit a peace officer as defined in Wis Stat. Sec. § 939.22(22) or armed forces or military personnel armed in the line of duty or any person duly authorized by the Chief of Police or County Sheriff to possess a firearm or other dangerous weapon in any public building.
- D. Should any section of provisions in this Ordinance be declared invalid for any reason by a court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance.
- E. This Ordinance shall become effective upon adoption and publication or posting as provided by law, pursuant to Sec. § 60.80 of the Wisconsin Statutes
