A RESOLUTION LIMITING USE OF THE TOWN HALL TO OFFICIAL TOWN BUSINESS AND ELECTIONS

WHEREAS, the Town Hall is a public building owned and maintained by the Town of Stubbs for the purpose of conducting official Town business and holding elections; and


WHEREAS, the Town Board has determined that it is in the best interests of the Town to limit use of the Town Hall to official Town business and elections only, in order to maintain order, security, and proper use of public resources;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Town Board of the Town of Stubbs, Rusk County, Wisconsin, as follows:


1. The Town Hall shall be used exclusively for official Town business, including but not limited to Town Board meetings, Board of Review, open book meetings, other official committee or commission meetings and working sessions, and all elections conducted by or on behalf of the Town.
2. Use of the Town Hall for private events, private group meetings, or any other non-Town official purposes is prohibited.
3. The Town Board may make exceptions to this policy by majority vote at a properly noticed meeting if it determines that such use serves a public purpose and is consistent with the interests of the Town.
4. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and shall remain in effect until amended or repealed by action of the Town Board.
