TOWN BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 2019-03**

**A RESOLUTION SETTING THE AMOUNT FOR
A BOND TO COVER POTENTIAL ROAD DAMAGE
UNDER TCG ORDINANCE SECTION 09.07(7)(B)**

WHEREAS, the Town of Cottage Grove adopted Ordinance Section 09.07 to limit the weight of vehicles on town roads to protect the public safety and promote the well being of residents of the Town of Cottage Grove, and

WHEREAS, the Town of Cottage Grove is aware that some vehicles must be exempted from Ordinance Section 09.07 and allowed to travel Town of Cottage Grove roads in excess of the posted weight limits in order to serve properly in the Town of Cottage Grove and to further promote the public well being and reasonable use of property in the Town of Cottage Grove, and

WHEREAS, Ordinance section 09.07(7)(b) states that a bond or certificate of insurance to cover potential road damage, in an amount determined by the Town Board, may be required prior to the issuance of a conditional use or variance permit,

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved that , when a bond is required, it shall be in an amount of \$ 1 million per mile of road permitted by the conditional use or variance permit.

This resolution was duly considered and adopted by the Cottage Grove Town Board pursuant to a vote of 5 for and 0 against and 0 abstentions on this 18th day of March, 2019.
