

Proof of Residence Required for Registering to Vote on Election Day:

The following constitute acceptable Proof-of-Residence if the document contains your current name and address and is valid on Election Day:

- A current and **valid WISCONSIN DRIVERS LICENSE.**
- A current and **valid WISCONSIN IDENTIFICATION CARD.**
- Any other **OFFICIAL IDENTIFICATION CARD OR LICENSE ISSUED BY A WISCONSIN GOVERNMENTAL BODY OR UNIT.**
- Any **IDENTIFICATION CARD ISSUED BY AN EMPLOYER** in the normal course of business and **BEARING A PHOTO of the card holder**, but not including a business card.
- A **REAL ESTATE TAX BILL OR RECEIPT** for the current year or the year preceding the date of the election.
- A **RESIDENTIAL LEASE** which is effective for a period that includes Election Day.
- A **UNIVERSITY, COLLEGE or TECHNICAL INSTITUTE PHOTO ID CARD**, ONLY if the bearer provides a fee receipt dated within the last nine months or the institution provides a certified housing list to the municipal clerk.
- A gas, electric or telephone service statement (**UTILITY BILL**) for the period commencing not earlier than 90 days before Election Day.
- **BANK STATEMENT.**
- **PAYCHECK.**
- **CHECK or OTHER DOCUMENT ISSUED BY A UNIT OF GOVERNMENT.**
