Proof of Residence Required for Registering to Vote on Election Day:

The following constitute acceptable Proof-of-Residence if the document contains your current name and address and is valid on Election Day:

- A current and valid WISCONSIN DRIVERS LICENSE.
- A current and valid WISCONSIN IDENTIFICATION CARD.
- Any other OFFICIAL IDENTIFICATION CARD OR LICENSE ISSUED BY A WISCONSIN GOVERNMENTAL BODY OR UNIT.
- Any IDENTIFICATION CARD ISSUED TY AN EMPLOYER in the normal course of business and BEARING A PHOTO of the card holder, but not including a business card.
- A REAL ESTATE TAX BILL OR RECEIPT for the current year or the year preceding the date of the election.
- A **RESIDENTIAL LEASE** which is effective for a period that includes Election Day.
- A UNIVERSITY, COLLEGE or TECHNICAL INSTITUTE PHOTO ID CARD, ONLY if the bearer provides a fee receipt dated within the last nine months or the institution provides a certified housing list to the municipal clerk.
- A gas, electric or telephone service statement (UTILITY BILL) for the period commencing not earlier than 90 days before Election Day.
- BANK STATEMENT.
- PAYCHECK.
- CHECK or OTHER DOCUMENT ISSUED BY A UNIT OF GOVERNMENT.
