## Types of Alcohol Licenses with Brief Description

**Class "A" license:** May sell fermented malt beverages in original packages or containers for off-premises consumption.

Class "B" license: May sell beer to consumers for on-premises or off-premises consumption.

**Temporary Class "B" (picnic) beer license:** May sell fermented malt beverages to consumers at a picnic or similar gathering of limited duration.

"Class A" license: May sell intoxicating liquor to consumers only in original packages or containers for off-premises consumption.

"Class B" license: May sell intoxicating liquor to consumers by the glass for on-premises consumption.
"Class C" license: May sell wine by the glass or in one opened original container for consumption on-premise. This license is for a restaurant in which the sale of all alcohol beverages accounts for less than 50 percent of gross receipts.
