Every eligible registered voter will receive a ballot by mail. Ballots are mailed approximately 21 days before an election. Ballots cannot be forwarded by the post office, so visit vote.utah.gov to check/update your voter information. Please use the ballot that is mailed to you. The cost of postage is covered so you don't need a stamp. After completing your ballot, just put it in the provided envelope, sign in the appropriate space, seal and mail it. **Mailed ballots MUST** be postmarked the day before the election, **November 20**. You may also **drop your ballot in our secure Curbside Dropbox at the Genola city office located at 74 W 800 S next to the mailbox**. OR in any secure Utah County Curbside Dropbox. Delivered ballots must be delivered in person to a Voting Assistance Center on Election Day, November 21, 2023. The nearest voting center can be found on utahcounty.gov.



November 13th-20th, 2023

Early Voting Period held at the Utah County Elections Division, 100 E. Center Street, Suite 3100 (3rd Floor), Provo, Utah. An individual who is not registered to vote, may vote with a provisional ballot with one primary form of ID or two secondary forms of ID. See Utah County Elections-Early Voting at utahcounty.gov.

To track your ballot, go to vote.utah.gov and click on the track my mail ballot icon and sign up.

ELECTION DAY

On Election Day, **November 21**, Voting Assistance Centers will be provided throughout Utah County to address voter concerns, issues, and receive help. **Please bring your mailed ballot with you**. If you do not bring your ballot, you will be required to vote provisionally so that election officials can verify that your mailed ballot was not already submitted. The Town Council passed Resolution No. 2023-03 to conduct the 2023 General Municipal Election according to UCA 20A-4-602, Municipal Alternate Voting Methods Pilot Project (Ranked Choice Voting).
