T-BALL Rules

- Games are 3-4 innings or 45 minutes. Games should always begin on schedule. It is up to the coaches to get games going in a timely manner, please be on time and get play going without delay.
- WEATHER: Coaches are to assume games will continue unless contacted by their Recreation Director. On site, if weather seems too harsh (too cold, too wet, too hot) for your team players, coaches are to determine jointly, whether, and how long to continue game time. In the event games are canceled or shortened for any reason they WILL NOT be rescheduled with the exception of games canceled by Recreation Directors.
- Coaches and parents are fully responsible for all players' full and absolute safety, be aware and be smart.
- Full uniform is required to play in the games. ("full uniform"=what your city has provided, baseball pants and cleats are NOT required in this league).
- No minimum player attendance required to participate in a game.
- Helmets MUST be worn by the batter, the on-deck batter, and by all base runners. Helmets must remain on the head until the child reaches the dugout. This is for your team players' absolute safety.
- Every player bats in every inning, inning is over when all players have batted and ran all the bases.
- Every player plays on the field, always placing one player on each base, one on the pitcher's mound and one catcher, placing remaining players infield between bases, no outfield players in this league. Be sure every child gets a turn at playing each position on the field.
- Catchers do not have gear in this league, be aware and on top of teaching, and keep your player at a safe distance from home plate to prevent the player from being harmed by bat and ball hits during play. It may be a good idea (though not required) to place a batting helmet on your catcher during play.
- Teach your players to catch/gain possession of the ball only when it is in their area of play, teach them to work together as a team by throwing the ball to each other during a play, ball play should go from the player in possession to the nearest base and pass through all 3 bases, then to the pitcher and finally to the catcher to be placed back on the "T". We do encourage teaching players to "tag" their opposing team as they run bases BUT no child is ever officially tagged "out", tagged players continue on to/stay on base.
- Batters are to hit then run to first base and stop, each player runs only one base per play, no base stealing, when the last batter in the line-up hits all players on bases run home.
- We do not keep score in T-Ball. This league is for learning purposes only.
