For many years the Town Council has wanted to build a second culinary water well and storage tank to help ensure that residents have sufficient water. Several times over the years the Town's well has broken. The well always breaks down during the heat of the summer. Santaquin has been great to allow the Town to pay for additional water in the past, but as the Town of Genola grows, it becomes more difficult for Santaquin to make up the shortfall. Fortunately, we now have a functional second well and storage tank. This enables the Town to perform maintenance and repairs as needed and provides us with a more secure water source, especially during times of drought.

#### **EASTER EGG HUNT**

#### FIRE DEPARTMENT

We would like to remind R1 residents that the spring open burn period this year will be April 1st through May 31th and September 15th through October 31st. Both these time periods are subject to the weather conditions. R1 zones will be able to get their burn permits online at air.utah.gov > OpenBurning > form, scroll down to "Online" and fill out the "complete online" form. Please remember to monitor your fire at all times while burning, always have a way to put it out quickly if needed. You are not allowed to burn anything that is not grown on your property. When finished make sure the fire is dead out before dark and never burn at night.

Residents in an A-1 zones and with 5.25 acres or more an agriculture burn permit can be obtained by emailing: genola.ag.burn.permit@gmail.com

Please include your name, address, phone number and estimated acreage and we will have one emailed back to you, these will be good for 2 years. As always, every fire will need to be called into the Utah County Burn line at 801-374-2876 they will advise you if it is a burn day or not. Be ready to give them your unique burn permit number that will be on the permit. Please read the permit as to what you can and cannot do, it is your responsibility to follow all conditions.

We would like to congratulate firefighter Sam Taylor for completing the 140-hour class to receive his certifications in Fire 1 & 2 which includes fire and hazmat operations. Sam has been a great asset for the department and the citizens of the Town of Genola.
