

RESOLUTION  
#01-2024-56

The Town of Buffalo Board having been approached by the local Snowmobile Club (Hilltop Trailblazers) for permission to allow use of the town highway designated as Plattes Valley Road, lying between Buffalo Ridge Lane and W263 Plattes Valley Road a distance of 1.5 miles from the intersection of Plattes Valley Road and Buffalo Ridge Lane to be used as a designated snowmobile trail because of conditions preventing snowmobiles from traveling in adjacent off road right-of-way.

THEREFORE, with specific authority pursuant to Wis.ss.350.18 and adopted by a majority of the town board on a roll call vote, the Town of Buffalo Board Supervisors do


HEREBY, designate a portion of the surface of Plattes Vly Road lying between Buffalo Ridge Ln and W263 Plattes Vly RD, a distance of 1.5 miles as a snowmobile route.

BE IT RESOLVED, the access on town highway designated with this resolution is for a period of the calendar year 2024 or until terminated for due cause (safety concerns, rules violations) by action of the Town of Buffalo Board Supervisors at a legally called and noticed meeting of the board.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Hilltop Trailblazers Snowmobile Club shall be responsible for procuring and paying for signs designating that portion of Plattes Valley Road accepted as a snowmobile route. The signs shall comply with all requirements of the state statutes concerning highway signage. The Hilltop Trailblazers Snowmobile Club (or its successors) shall be responsible for installing separate snowmobile directional and guidance signs along this snowmobile route and, where reasonably feasible, direct snowmobile traffic to use Town of Buffalo Road right-of-way rather than highway surface.
