1: Floodplain delineations are for flood insurance purposes only. All areas subject to flooding in the community are not necessarily shown.

2: A hydric soil is a soil formed under conditions of saturation, flooding, or ponding long enough during the growing season to develop anaerobic conditions in the upper part. Soils in Lincoln County that fall under this designation are Forrdum Loam (Fh), Loxley and Dawson Peats (Lo), Lupton, Cathro, and Markey Mucks (Lu), and Minocqua and Capitola Mucks (Ms).

3: The wetland layer was produced by the WDNR on orthorectified aerial photography. This layer does not include all wetlands that may be subject to state or federal disturbance rules.

4: Slope was calculated from the Lincoln County DEM which was acquired in 2008 using LIDAR data.



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
