Whereas, the Clerk of the Town of Scott issues retail liquor licenses under Section 125 Wis. Stats.; and,

Whereas, the Town Board of the Town of Scott adopts the following standards under which the clerk shall issue a provisional retail license:

The Town Clerk may issue a provisional retail license under Section 125.185 Wis. Stats. to a person who has applied for a Class "A" Class "B", "Class A", "Class B", "Class C" license under the following circumstances:

- 1. The time between receipt of said *Application* and the next regular town board meeting does not allow sufficient time for proper publication of the *Application*.
- 2. Business operations would be disrupted or severely impacted by a lapse in licensing due to a sale of the business or its assets.
- 3. Special circumstances, as explained in writing by the applicant and approved by the Town Board, exist to warrant a provisional license being issued.

The fee for a provisional license shall be \$15, payable to Town of Scott. Payment must be received prior to any provisional license being issued.

All provisional licenses will expire sixty (60) days from the date issued or when the regular retail license is issued, whichever comes first.

This ordinance is effective upon posting and shall remain in effect until further action by the board.

The town clerk shall properly post or publish this ordinance as required under s.  $\underline{60.80}$ , Wis. stats.
