ORDINANCE NUMBER 3

Ordinance Town of Scott

The Town Board of the Town of Scott, Lincoln County, Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:

That any and all roads to be hereinafter accepted as part of the town road system shall be required to meet the following specifications:

- 1. Minimum right of way shall be four (4) rods.
- 2. Minimum width of roadbed shall be thirty (30) feet.
- 3. Minimum width of hard surface (bituminous to be twenty (20) feet, over a gravel base of (1000) yards per mile, for an average depth of four (4) inches.
- 4. Such bridges and/or culverts as deemed necessary by the town board shall be installed.
- 5. All dead-end roads shall have a sixty (60) foot diameter cleared turn around area.
- 6. All cuts and fills shall have no less than one to one grade.
- 7. All roads shall meet approval by inspection of the town board and the County Highway Department.
- 8. All roads shall further meet standards set by Wis. Stat. 86.28 (#3 100 to 250 A.D.T.

This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication as provided by law.

The foregoing ordinance was adopted at a regular meeting of the town board of the Town of Scott on June H ~ 1980.
