Approving a “Class B: Liquor License for a “Qualifying event venue” Requirements


WHEREAS, The Town of Scott, Lincoln County Wisconsin does not have any liquor licenses available in our quota.

WHEREAS, The State of Wisconsin is allowing an “above the quota” Class B liquor license issuance for a “qualifying event venue”. Sec. 125.51(4)(v)5 Wis. Stats.


WHEREAS, The State of Wisconsin is certifying “qualifying event venue”/s in the state. Wi Sec. 125.24(5)(b). Wis. Stats.

WHEREAS, The Town of Scott supports our citizens and promotes commerce.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Town of Scott, Lincoln County Wisconsin town board is authorizing “qualifying event venues” to obtain a Class B liquor license if certified as a qualifying event venue with documentation by the State of Wisconsin. As this is not a license that the Town of Scott currently issues the Fee for the License, The Town of Scott sets the fee for the initial issuance at \$260. The annual fee for this Class B liquor license will be the regular renewal fee for a Class B liquor license.
