## CODIFIED LAW #2 TOWN OF MISSION HILL

## PAYMENT ON ACCOUNTS AND CLAIMS AGAINST THE TOWN

BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of Mission Hill, SD:

All accounts and claims against the Town of Mission Hill shall be made out fully and itemized and the same shall not be allowed by the Board of Trustees of said Town unless the person in whose favor such account, claim, or demand shall be, shall reduce the same to writing and shall verify the same to the effect that such account, claim or demand is just and true; that the money therein charged was actually paid for the purposes therein stated; that the property therein charged for was actually delivered or used for the purposes therein stated and was of the value therein charged or that the fees or amounts charged therefor are such as allowed by law, and that no part of such account, claim, or demand has been paid.
