CODIFIED LAW #5 TOWN OF MISSION HILL

ANIMALS RUNNING AT LARGE WITHIN CITY LIMITS

BE IT ORDAINED by the President and the Board of Trustees of Mission Hill, SD:

Section I. It shall be unlawful for any person or persons to permit any horse, cattle, swine, sheep, goat, or other animal or animals, to run at large within the corporate limits of the Town of Mission Hill.

Section II. Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction, be fined the sum of \$20.00 that must be paid to Finance Officer in 15 days or the fine increases in accordance with Ordinance 112, Section 6.
