## CODIFIED LAW #7 TOWN OF MISSION HILL

## STORING OF EXPLOSIVES WITHIN CITY LIMITS

BE IT ORDAINED by the President and the Board of Trustees of Mission Hill, SD:

**Section I.** No person, company, or corporation shall keep or store any gun or blasting powder, or other like explosive substance in any house, shop, or other place within the Town of Mission Hill, except in such place as shall have been approved by the Board of Trustees of said Town for that purpose; provided, that any person, company, or corporation engaged in retailing powder, may keep for purpose of retail only, a quantity of gun powder not to exceed 200 (two hundred) pounds at any one time at his or their place of business; provided further, that all powder so kept for sale shall be kept in fire-proof boxes or canisters out of doors, remote from fires, lighted lamps, candles, or gas jets, and so that same can be readily removed in case of fire; and it shall be the duty of the Marshal to see that dealers in powder and other explosives comply with the provisions of the ordinance.

**Section II.** It shall be unlawful for any person, persons, or corporation to store or keep for sale within the fire limits of the Town of Mission Hill, any crude petroleum, gasoline, naptha, benzine, burning fluid, or turpentine in any quantity exceeding 1 (one) barrel of 50 (fifty) gallons, and then the same shall be kept in a galvanized iron tank, or in a cellar, the floor of which much be at least 5 (five) feet below the grade of the street adjacent thereto.

**Section III.** Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction, be fined the sum of \$20.00 (twenty) dollars to be paid to the Finance Officer in 15 days, or the fine increases in accordance with Ordinance 112, Section 6.
