

RESOLUTION 2022-02

**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN ADJUSTMENT TO THE TOWN LEVY LIMIT FOR THE
INCREASES IN CHARGES ASSESSED BY THE B.U.G. FIRE DISTRICT**

WHEREAS, an adjustment to the town levy limit is allowed for increases in charges assessed by a joint fire department organized under Wisconsin Statute 66.0602(3)(h) for each governing body served by the joint department, and

WHEREAS, the allowable adjustment may not exceed the following:

The difference in the total charges assessed by the joint fire department for the current year increase, relative to the total charges assessed by the joint fire department for the previous year, multiplied by the Consumer Price Index for urban customers, U.S. City average, as determined by the U.S. Department of Labor for the preceding 12 months ending on September 30 in the year of the levy, plus two percent; and

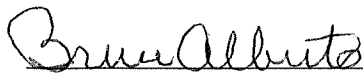
WHEREAS, each governing body served by the joint department must adopt a resolution in favor of exceeding the limit, and

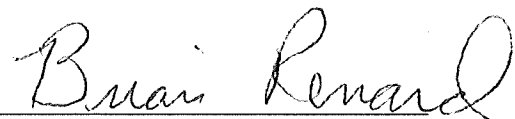
WHEREAS, the Town of Union is a governing body served by the Brussels, Union and Gardner Fire Department;

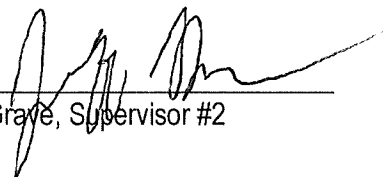
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the town board of the Town of Union, Door County, Wisconsin, approves an adjustment to the tax levy limit for increases in charges assessed by the Brussels, Union and Gardner Fire Department as determined above for the 2023 tax levy and all future tax levies until determined otherwise.

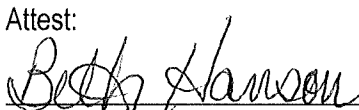
