An Ordinance Amending Ordinances 2024-05

Designation of Class B Highways

The Town Board of Supervisors of the Town of Union, Door County, Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:

- 1. **AUTHORITY/PURPOSE**. This Ordinance is based upon authority granted by Wis. Stats. Section 60.22 (3) and 349.15 (2). The purpose of this ordinance is to amend the Town of Union ordinances designating Class B Highways within the Town of Union.
- 2. **AMENDMENT**. Existing Ordinances 2024-05 of the Town of Union, Door County, Wisconsin, are hereby amended as follows:
 - A. The following Highways in the Town of Union are designated Class "B" Highways subject to the weight limits as set forth in Wis. Stats. §348.16 (2) as amended, unless such limits are increased by Town Ordinance:

Brussels Road Gardner Road to Ledge Road and CTH DK to State Hwy 57

Pit Road...... CTH DK south to termination

Tru Way Road Gardner Rd south to Ledge Rd and County Hwy D south to County Hwy X

- B. The town chairperson, or designee, shall place appropriate traffic signs on the above-described highways on or before the effective date of this ordinance.
- C. No person may operate any vehicle on the above noted highways in violation of the weight limit set forth in §348.16 (2), Wis. Stats., as amended. Upon conviction for a violation of this ordinance, the violator shall pay a forfeiture of not less than \$1,000.00 nor more than \$5,000.00, plus the applicable surcharges, assessments, and cost for each violation. Each trip in violation of this ordinance constitutes a separate offense. In addition, the Town may seek injunctive relief to enjoin further violations.
- 3. **EFFECTIVE DATE**. This ordinance shall take effect on the day following its publication.
- 4. **POSTING.** The town clerk shall properly post or publish this ordinance as required under Wis. Stats. §60.80.
