FIREWORKS PERMIT

Wisconsin statute 167.10 prohibits the use or possession of fireworks, as defined under 167.10, without a user's permit issued by the chairperson of a town – or their representative – in which the possession or use is to occur. Permits can only be issued to one of the following: 1. A public authority; 2. A fair association; 3. An amusement park; 4. A park board; 5. A civic organization; 6. Any individual or group of individuals; 7. An agricultural producer for the protection of crops from predatory birds or animals.

A person who possesses or uses fireworks without a valid permit is subject to a forfeiture of up to \$1,000 per violation. See Wis. Stat. §167.10(9)(b). Each firework illegally used or possessed may be a separate violation.

NOTE: Permits cannot be issued to a minor; they must be 18 years of age or older per statute 167.10(3)(h). A copy of this permit shall be on file with the clerk of the town. The permit is valid only within the boundaries of the Town of Union.

This permit may only be issued based on the following conditions or restrictions:

1. The Town of Union shall not be liable in any civil action, for any accident or injury caused during the transportation, handling, storage or use of said fireworks.
2. The Town Chairman, B.U.G. Fire Chief or their designees reserve the right to cancel/call off any permitted fireworks display for reasons of health or safety.
3. Permittee is responsible to submit this permit application to the Town of Union Clerk or Chairman at least **one week prior** to any display of fireworks.

4. No firework displays may be launched over neighboring properties specifically not owned by the requestor/permittee without first getting permission from said neighbor or property owner.
(Permission Requires Signatures below)
5. Permittee is responsible for damages or injuries to person(s) or property and should have appropriate liability insurance coverage for holding such an event.
6. Permittee is responsible for cleanup of neighboring properties from any and all debris caused from the fireworks display.
7. (Over Land) This permit becomes void if wind conditions exist greater than **8 miles per hour** prior to display being set off over land.
8. (Over Water) This permit becomes void if wind direction changes to cause display of fireworks to blow back over land and wind speeds exist greater than **8 miles per hour** prior to display.
9. This permit becomes **VOID** during periods of extreme dry conditions, **winds exist of greater than 8 miles per hour**, or when other fire hazard warnings have been issued by the DNR, Fire Department, Emergency Management, County Government or Local Town Government.
10. This permit may be revised at any time by the issuing authority.
