

## NOTICE TO BIDDERS

Sealed bids will be received by the City of Olean DPW, 101 East State Street, Police Dispatch Window (NE side of Municipal Building on Times Square), Olean, NY, 14760 until 2:00 pm, Friday, April 24, 2020, at which time they will be publicly opened and read aloud inside the Olean Municipal Building, Room 119.

The proposed project is located in the City of Olean, Cattaraugus County.

The work includes providing all labor, materials, machinery, tools, equipment and other means of construction necessary and incidental to the completion of the work shown on the plans and described in these specifications.

Bids will be received for the following:

Base Bid, Highway Rehabilitation of Main Street from Union Street to Front Street and Front Street from Union Street to 1st Ave;

Bid Alternate No. 1, Raised Center Median on Front Street;

Bid Alternate No. 2, Street Lighting on Main South of the Bridge over Olean Creek.

The Bidder shall be aware of the alternate bidding process and award of the contract procedure to be utilized. The criteria and formula for determining the award of the contract is outlined in the General Requirements section 2.1 – Consideration of Proposals.

Payment can be submitted only by company check or money order made payable to City of Olean. NO CASH AND NO PERSONAL CHECKS.

Contractors that obtain contract documents from a source other than the issuing office must notify the issuing office in order to be placed in the official plan holder's list, to receive addenda and other bid correspondence. Bids received from contractors other than those on the official plan holder's list, will not be accepted.

A pre-bid meeting will not be held.

Bid proposals may also be "overnight" or otherwise shipped to the above address. Bids received after 2:00 pm local time on the day of the bid opening will not be opened and will be returned to the bidder. Such bids will not be considered.

This is a Unit Price bid. No bidder may withdraw his bid within forty five (45) calendar days after the actual date of the opening thereof. Each bid must be accompanied by a bid security in the amount of 5 % of the base bid in accordance with the Instruction to Bidders.

The successful bidder will be required to furnish construction performance and payment bonds in the full amount of the contract price.

The successful bidder will be required to comply with all provisions of the Federal Government Equal Opportunity clauses issued by the Secretary of Labor on May 21, 1968 and published in the Federal Register (41 CFR Part 60-1, 33 F.2 7804).
