

CITY OF OLEAN RECOMMENDED CODE OF BEHAVIOR

All participants in the league (including players, coaches, officials and spectators) must be courteous and act in a professional manner that reflects good sportsmanship at all times.

Disruptive and/or inappropriate behavior will not be tolerated, this includes but is not limited to:

1. Taunting players, coaches, officials or spectators by means of ridiculing, baiting, threatening physical violence, or physical violence.
2. Using obscene or vulgar language in any manner to anyone at any time.
3. Throwing any object into games or viewing areas that could create a distraction or a safety hazard.
4. Harassment or intimidation of players, coaches, officials or spectators by means of hostile, threatening and/or abusive verbal, written comments, or physical force.

Activities, including games, practices, meetings and any other league-related functions will be stopped when disruptive and/or inappropriate behavior is displayed that interferes with spectators or participants. Violators displaying inappropriate and/or disruptive behavior will be identified to coaches/officials and the league shall take immediate action. For physical violations, Police Officers will be called and a police report filed. Expulsion from the sporting event will occur immediately. **For all violations, a Record of Unsportsmanlike Conduct shall be filed with the Youth & Recreation Division. If someone continually behaves in unsportsmanlike conduct, the City may enforce a policy that includes not allowing the violator at any sporting event held in city parks/facilities.**
