Structure Fire 312 W. Green St.

On February 14, 2026, at 2:20 p.m., the City of Olean Fire Department was dispatched to a reported structure fire with smoke in the area of 312 S. 3rd St., while units were responding, dispatch advised that there were reports of people trapped.

Engine 39 arrived in the area and found no smoke conditions. Personnel from the Olean Police Department were flagged down near Green Street and advised that the correct address was 312 W. Green St.

Upon arrival at the correct location, fire units observed multiple occupants evacuating the structure and smoke visible throughout the building. A hose line was deployed, and crews located a room and contents fire on the first floor. The fire was extinguished, and a search of the residence was conducted with no additional occupants located. The building was ventilated and the fire deemed under control at 2:45 p.m.

Multiple occupants were evaluated on scene and transported to Olean General Hospital by Trans Am Ambulance and Allegany EMS. The City of Olean Fire Department was assisted on scene by Olean Police, Trans Am Ambulance, Allegany EMS, and Portville Fire Department's air truck. The cause of the fire remains under investigation.
