TOWN OF BAILEYS HARBOR Amend ORDINANCE NO. 05 -15 Parking Lots "A & B" Trailer Parking Ordinance

WHEREAS, it is in the public interest and welfare of the Town of Baileys Harbor to establish regulations for parking at Brann Field Parking Lot "B" (formerly known as Gerdman Park) & Parking Lot "A" in the Town of Baileys Harbor;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Town Board of Supervisors of the Town of Baileys Harbor, Door County, Wisconsin, does ordain as follows:

Section 1 - Authority

This ordinance is adopted pursuant to the authority granted in Wis. Stats. §60.22(3) and Wis. Stats. §61.34 to enact ordinances and regulations promoting and protecting the health, safety, welfare and convenience of the public and defining and prohibiting public nuisances.

Section 2 - Purpose

The purpose of this ordinance is to promote and protect the health, safety, welfare and convenience of the public in their use of parks in the Town of Baileys Harbor.

Section 3 – No Parking

A. Definition.

Trailer: A vehicle without motive power designed for carrying persons or property on its own structure and to be drawn by a vehicle with motive power. The term trailer shall include, but is not limited to, trailer coach, semitrailer, travel trailer, utility trailer, boat trailer, and storage trailer.

B. No Parking.

Amendment

It shall be unlawful for any person to park any detached trailer defined in Section 3 (A) of this ordinance upon Parcel No. 002220613B, known as Brann Field Parking Lot "B" (formerly known as Gerdman Park). It shall be unlawful for any person to park any detached trailer defined in Section 3 (A) of this ordinance upon parcel No. 0020320302811N, Parking Lot "A". It is unlawful to overnight park any motorized vehicle and/or detached trailer defined in section 3 in Parking Lots "A & B" in the Town of Baileys Harbor, Door County, Wisconsin.

Section 4 – Penalties

Any person, firm or corporation violating this ordinance shall be subject to a forfeiture of \$25 for each offense; and a separate offense shall be deemed committed on each day during on which a violation occurs or continues.

Section 5 – Effective Date

This ordinance shall be effective on the day after its publication.

Section 6 – Effective Date:

The ordinance shall take effective on the day after its publication.
