DOG LICENSE

The annual dog tags are in for 2023 and can be purchased at any time.

ALL DOGS MUST BE LICENSED BY APRIL 1:

LICENSE RATES ARE FOR EACH DOG:

Male & Female \$8.50 / Neutered Male & Spayed Female \$3.50 ANYONE THAT HAS 4 OR MORE DOGS ARE REQUIRED TO PURCHASE A KENNEL LICENSE OR MULTIPLE DOG LICENSES.

Multiple Dog License (Up to 12) \$36.50

Property taxes will be mailed shortly from the Brown County Treasurer's office. Make all checks out to that office. You can pay either by mail or in person at the County Treasure's office. Owners must present their RABIES VACCINATION CERTIFICATE that their dog is vaccinated against rabies by a veterinarian before the dog can be licensed. I also need the Pet Owners phone number for Dog license report sent to the Brown County Clerks Office. THIS RULE WILL BE STRICTLY FOLLOWED!!!!!
